In addition, Outreach offers an Early Admission Program (<https://www.swccd.edu/admissions-and-financial-aid/outreach/high-school-early-admissions/>) (EAP) for all interested high school seniors and first-time college students. Those who complete the Early Admissions steps by the deadline in Mid-May receive priority registration for the fall semester. Outreach peer ambassadors (<https://www.swccd.edu/admissions-and-financial-aid/outreach/high-school-early-admissions/peer-ambassador.aspx>) are available at each Sweetwater Union High School District high school, partner charter schools, and SUHSD adult schools. Peer Ambassadors are also available at Southwestern College to help first-time students with college applications and general questions.
