The Outreach Office provides information about college programs, available services offered, and enrollment procedures and costs. In addition, Outreach conducts an Early Admission Program (<https://www.swccd.edu/admissions-and-financial-aid/outreach/high-school-early-admissions/>) (EAP) for all interested high school seniors. The program allows high school seniors to apply and receive priority registration for the fall semester. Outreach peer ambassadors (<https://www.swccd.edu/admissions-and-financial-aid/outreach/high-school-early-admissions/peer-ambassador.aspx>) work at each of the high schools in the Sweetwater Union High School District and are available in the counseling centers to help seniors with their college application.
